014, 12-13 – Student Internet Access

1. Page 2, Section 2 – Instructions to Proposers – AISD indicates that the bid package has a label included; however, no label was included. Please clarify if AISD requires a specific mailing label for submitting RFP responses?
 - a. A label was not provided. Vendor will provide shipping container and shall properly label with RFP number, description and proposal opening date and time
2. Page 8, Section 22 – Insurance Requirements – AISD refers to a Workers' Compensation Attachment; however, there was no such attachment with the RFP. Please provide the Worker's Compensation Attachment for vendor's review?
 - a. Disregard reference to attachment.
3. Page 8, Section 1.0 – General – AISD refers to DNS. Please clarify the definition of DNS.
 - a. Domain Name System - The Internet maintains two principal namespaces, the domain name hierarchy and the Internet Protocol (IP) address system. The Domain Name System maintains the domain namespace and provides translation services between these two namespaces.
4. Page 15, Section 3.2.1.d – Internet Access Services Specifications – AISD indicates that the District will provide a private IP range and DHCP for internal access. Please clarify DHCP?
 - a. The Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol (DHCP) is a network protocol that is used to configure network devices so that they can communicate on an IP network. A DHCP client uses the DHCP protocol to acquire configuration information, such as an IP address, a default route and one or more DNS server addresses from a DHCP server. The DHCP client then uses this information to configure its host. Once the configuration process is complete, the host is able to communicate on the internet.
