**WALK THROUGH QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:**

Q: Can we get maps of all of the schools to help determine cable lengths?

A: Maps are being generated and will be provided as they are completed. This will be posted at:

Q: The specification states Panduit parts, but we see that most of the installations now use Titan parts. Does it matter that we use Panduit parts or would an equivalent part be OK?

A: Yes, it would be OK.

Q: The specification states Systimax cabling. Can we substitute?

A: No. The district standard is as posted.

Q: We are being asked to work after school during school times. Would we have full access during the summer?

A: Yes, depending on the custodian schedule and if summer school is in session at that particular school.

Q: Do the portables have conduit connecting them?

A: No. Portable connectivity route will be provided by the vendor. Aerial is acceptable.

Q: If we relocate a rack and the cables are too short, would we recable?

A: AISD will consider recabling a few connections, but if the entire patch panel is too short, it will have to remain as a wall mount rack and would not be recabled.

Q: Does the bid form have portables and moving wall mounts to racks?
